1) A Water Conversation

- The Lake Windermere Ambassadors will host a community conversation about water on December 10th, 6-8pm, at Copper Point Resort. Guest speaker Dr. Anna Warwick Sears from the Okanagan Basin Water Board will share stories about local watershed management.
