



Highlights of Board Meeting ~ September 26th 2012

1) Election of Megan Kinley as Youth Board member for 2012-2013

- Megan will work with the Board to develop a strategy for how to better engage young people in lake stewardship.

2) Windermere Creek

- The Ambassadors Board is continuing to work on ways to help fund a geotechnical study of Windermere Creek.
- Funding has been secured from several sources, but there is still a significant shortfall.

3) Lake Windermere Groyne

- The Board agreed to enable a process for the DOI, RDEK and the community to converse with the Federal government in regards to the future of the Lake Windermere groyne.

4) Safe Boating Code of Conduct

- Due to an increase in various hazards on the lake, Board members discussed the need to engage with the Watersports Association and the local marinas to come up with a strategy to encourage safe boating behaviour on the lake.
