



Highlights of Board Meeting ~ May 22nd 2013

1) Fee for Service Agreement with the District of Invermere

- The Board motioned to approve the Fee for Service Agreement with the DOI for 2013-2014.
- In return for the value the Lake Windermere Ambassadors provide to the community in their role as Lake Management Committee, the DOI will provide \$10,000 annually.

2) “This is our Watershed” – A Community Conversation

- The Lake Windermere Ambassadors hosted a workshop about our watershed on April 9th 2013. Approximately 30 people attended.
- Five guest speakers presented information on values and risks in the watershed.
- In order to keep the watershed conversation going after the workshop, Board members will meet to discuss next steps while continuing to work on community education.

3) Spring Activities

- The Lake Windermere Ambassadors held two lake tours during Wings Over the Rockies. The tours were very popular and well received by participants. The tour would not have been possible without Pete from Pete’s Marina who volunteered his time and pontoon boat.
- New plants have been added to the Kinsmen Beach shoreline as part of Phase III of the restoration project.

4) Regatta 2013

- August 11th is being considered as a new date for the Lake Windermere Regatta (Summer Splash)

5) Presentation by Peter Evans, Rotary Club of Invermere

- Peter Evans presented Rotary’s plans for a Spray Park to be constructed at Kinsmen Beach
